V16-17 – 5th Year of Joram (Son/Ahab) King/Israel – 8 Years

V18 – Walked in Ways of Kings/Israel (Even though he is King/Judah) - Evil

V18 – Because – the daughter of Ahab was his wife

A - What does the Bible say about this?

2 Corinthians 6:14-15 ¹⁴Do not be unequally yoked together with unbelievers. For what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness? And what communion has light with darkness? ¹⁵And what accord has Christ with Belial? Or what part has a believer with an unbeliever?

V19 –

A - The mercy of God in the OT!

Genesis 19:16 ¹⁶And while he lingered, the men took hold of his hand, his wife's hand, and the hands of his two daughters, the Lord being merciful to him, and they brought him out and set him outside the city.

Exodus 34:6 ⁶And the Lord passed before him and proclaimed, "The Lord, the Lord God, #1 = merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abounding in goodness and truth,

Acts 26:28 ²⁸Then Agrippa said to Paul, "You almost persuade me to become a Christian."

1 Peter 4:14-16 ¹⁴If you are reproached for the name of Christ, blessed are you, for the Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you. On their part He is blasphemed, but on your part He is glorified. ¹⁵But let none of you suffer as a murderer, a thief, an evildoer, or as a busybody in other people's matters. ¹⁶Yet if anyone suffers as a Christian, let him not be ashamed, but let him glorify God in this matter.
