

## Christmas (Eve) Day 2017 Jesus Saves

**Matthew 1:18-(21)** - And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name **JESUS**, for **He** will **save** His **people** from their **sins**.”

\* That is God’s will, His desire, that Jesus would save us from our sins...

### **Hebrews 10:5-7**

<sup>5</sup> **Therefore, when He came into the world, He said:**

**“Sacrifice and offering You did not desire,**

**1 Samuel 15:22** - So Samuel said: “Has the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, As in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, And to heed than the fat of rams.

\* **Hebrews 10:1-4** – Just as No New Year resolution has power/accomplish/desired results

**But a body You have prepared for Me.**

\* **Hebrews 10:8-10** – Tonight look at Man ravaged/sin, woman shamed/sin, condemned/law

<sup>6</sup> ***In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin  
You had no pleasure.***

**Amos 5:22–24** - Though you offer Me burnt offerings and your grain offerings, I will not accept them, Nor will I regard your fattened peace offerings. **23** Take away from Me the noise of your songs, For I will not hear the melody of your stringed instruments. **24** But let justice run down like water, And righteousness like a mighty stream.

**Micah 6:6–8** - With what shall I come before the LORD, And bow myself before the High God? Shall I come before Him with burnt offerings, With calves a year old? **7** Will the LORD be pleased with thousands of rams, Ten thousand rivers of oil? Shall I give my firstborn for my transgression, The fruit of my body for the sin of my soul? **8** He has shown you, O man, what is good; And what does the LORD require of you But to do justly, To love mercy, And to walk humbly with your God?

\* It’s like 1,000 Christmas gifts under the tree without Love!

<sup>7</sup> ***Then I said, ‘Behold, I have come—***

***In the volume of the book it is written of Me—***

When he would come – **Daniel 9:25** – Exactly 483 yrs from the command/rebuild Jerusalem (445 BC)

Where he would be born – **Micah 5:2** - “But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, Though you are little among the thousands of Judah, Yet out of you shall come forth to Me The One to be Ruler in Israel, Whose goings forth are from of old, From everlasting.”

His Lineage – **Genesis 49:10** - The scepter shall not depart from Judah, Nor a lawgiver from between his feet, Until Shiloh comes; And to Him shall be the obedience of the people.

\* J. Hampton Keathly III - A child born in the line of Shem, Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Judah, Jesse, David, and Solomon.

He would be born of a Virgin & God in the flesh - **Isaiah 7:14** - Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel.

He would be the Son of God - **Isaiah 9:6** - For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

**John 5:39–40** - You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are they which testify of Me. **40** But you are not willing to come to Me that you may have life.

### ***To do Your will, O God.' ”***

**John 4:34** - Jesus said to them, “My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me, and to finish His work.

**John 6:38** - For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me.

**Matthew 26:39** - He went a little farther and fell on His face, and prayed, saying, “O My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as You will.”

**39** This is the will of the Father who sent Me, that of all He has given Me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up at the last day. **40** And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may have everlasting life; and I will raise him up at the last day.”

### **Conclusion**

Today we have an opportunity to believe all that is written of Him in the volume of the book  
To receive the Will of God for our lives – To be saved from our sins and given eternal life!

**Isaiah 59:1–2** - Behold, the LORD’s hand is not shortened, That it cannot save; Nor His ear heavy, That it cannot hear. **2** But your iniquities have separated you from your God; And your sins have hidden His face from you... [So that He will not hear].
