**3/30/18**

**Isaiah 53:1–12**

**1** Who has believed our report? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?

**Fulfilled/quoted in John 12:37–38** - But although He had done so many signs before them, they did not believe in Him, **38** that the word of Isaiah the prophet might be fulfilled, which he spoke: “**Lord, who has believed our report? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?**” (Also in Rom 10:16)

**2** For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, And as a root out of dry ground. He has no form (stately) or comeliness (splendor); And when we see Him, There is no beauty (appearance) that we should desire Him.

**Fulfilled in Luke 2:39–40** - So when they had performed all things according to the law of the Lord, they returned to Galilee, to their own city, Nazareth. **40** And the Child grew and became strong in spirit, filled with wisdom; and the grace of God was upon Him.

\* **No Cliff Curtis/“Risen”; Brian Deacon/The Jesus Story; Diogo Morgado/Son of God;**

**3** He is despised and rejected by men, A Man of sorrows (pains) and acquainted with grief (sickness/disease). And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.

\* **Fulfilled in:**

**John 1:10–11** - He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him. **11** He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him.

**John 19:15** - But they cried out, “Away with Him, away with Him! Crucify Him!” Pilate said to them, “Shall I crucify your King?” The chief priests answered, “We have no king but Caesar!”

**4** Surely He has borne our griefs (sicknesses/disease) And carried our sorrows (pains); Yet we esteemed (reckoned/accounted) Him **stricken**, Smitten (struck down) by God, and **afflicted**.

\* **Fulfilled in Matthew 8:14–17** - Now when Jesus had come into Peter’s house, He saw his wife’s mother lying sick with a fever. **15** So He touched her hand, and the fever left her. And she arose and served them. **16** When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick, **17** that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: “**He Himself took our infirmities And bore our sicknesses.**”

\* **He is able to bear our grief/carry our sorrow (pain) so we don’t have to bear it alone!**

**5** But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.

\* **What happened to Him for Us!**

Wounded – pierced through; Heb/profaned;

Transgressions – Heb/rebellion, knowing what is right, doing wrong

Bruised – crushed; Heb/shattered

Iniquities – perversity/depravity

Chastisement – discipline/punishment

Stripes – blows that cut in (intended to get a confession)

Healed – all these are in the passive – we received from what He went through

\* **Romans 4:25, 5:6, 5:8, 8:32; Heb 9:28; 1 Cor 15:3**

6 All we like sheep have gone astray; We have turned, every one, to his own way; And the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.

\* **Just as in Gen 22 Abraham laid/wood upon Isaac shoulder/carried/Mt. Moriah**

\* **Fulfilled in Jesus/they laid/wood cross/instrument/judgment/carried/same Mt. Moriah**  
**John 19:2** - And the soldiers twisted a crown of thorns and put it on His head, and they put on Him a purple robe.

**John 19:17** - And He, bearing His cross, went out to a place called the Place of a Skull, which is called in Hebrew, Golgotha,

7 He was **oppressed** and He was **afflicted**, Yet He opened not His mouth; He was led as a lamb to the slaughter, And as a sheep before its shearers is silent, So He opened not His mouth.

**Fulfilled Exodus 12:6** - Now you shall keep it until the fourteenth day of the same month. Then the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it at twilight...**13** Now the blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you are. And when I see the blood, I will pass over you; and the plague shall not be on you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt.

**Fulfilled in Matthew 26:62-63** - And the high priest arose and said to Him, "Do You answer nothing? What is it these men testify against You?" **63** But Jesus kept silent. And the high priest answered and said to Him, "I put You under oath by the living God: Tell us if You are the Christ, the Son of God!"

\* **Despised, rejected, afflicted, wounded, bruised, chastened, scourged, oppressed, Yet...**

\* **Didn't open His mouth/defend Himself – if He did, He would have had to tell/truth!**

8 He was taken from prison and from judgment, And who will declare His generation? For He was cut off from the land of the living; For the transgressions of My people He was stricken.

\* **Here is the reason! He was cut off for the land of the living, for the transgressions...**

**Fulfilled Daniel 9:26** - "And after the sixty-two weeks Messiah shall be cut off, but not for Himself; And the people of the prince who is to come Shall destroy the city and the sanctuary. The end of it shall be with a flood, And till the end of the war desolations are determined.

\* **V7-8 Confirmed/Quoted Acts 8:32-33** – Scripture Ethiopian/reading & Phillip explained

9 And they made His grave with the wicked— But with the rich at His death, Because He had done no violence, Nor was any deceit in His mouth.

\* **Fulfilled in Matthew 27:57-60** - Now when evening had come, there came a rich man from Arimathea, named Joseph, who himself had also become a disciple of Jesus. **58** This man went to Pilate and asked for the body of Jesus. Then Pilate commanded the body to be given to him. **59** When Joseph had taken the body, he wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, **60** and laid it in his new tomb which he had hewn out of the rock; and he rolled a large stone against the door of the tomb, and departed.

\* **Crucified w/wicked; and should have been thrown out w/wicked;**

\* **But because He had not done any violence, (attested to by Pilate), Nor deceit/ mouth – Pilate granted his body to Joseph of Arimathea**

**10** Yet it pleased the LORD to **bruise** (crush) Him; He has put Him to grief. //When You make His soul an offering for sin, He shall see His seed, He shall prolong His days, And the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in His hand.

**Fulfilled in Matthew 26:36** - Then Jesus came with them to a place called **Gethsemane**, and said to the disciples, "Sit here while I go and pray over there."

**Luke 22:44** - And being in agony, He prayed more earnestly. Then His sweat became like great drops of blood falling down to the ground.

\* **Gethsemane** – Greek word/2 Aramaic words Gath – winepress; Shemen – ointment/oil

**11** He shall see the labor of His soul, and be satisfied. By His knowledge My righteous Servant shall justify many, For He shall bear their iniquities.

**1 Peter 2:24–25** who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed. **25** For you were like sheep going astray, but have now returned to the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls.

**12** Therefore I will divide Him a portion with the great, And He shall divide the spoil with the strong, Because He poured out His soul unto death, And He was numbered with the transgressors, And He bore the sin of many, And made intercession for the transgressors.

**Fulfilled in Luke 22:35–37** - And He said to them, "When I sent you without money bag, knapsack, and sandals, did you lack anything?" So they said, "Nothing." **36** Then He said to them, "But now, he who has a money bag, let him take it, and likewise a knapsack; and he who has no sword, let him sell his garment and buy one. **37** For I say to you that this which is written must still be accomplished in Me: '**And He was numbered with the transgressors.**' For the things concerning Me have an end."

\* He made intercession...

**Fulfilled in Luke 23:34** - Then Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do." And they divided His garments and cast lots.

\* He lives to make intercession...

**Hebrews 7:25** - Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.

**Romans 8:34** - Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us.

**Hebrews 9:24** - For Christ has not entered the holy places made with hands, which are copies of the true, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us;

**1 John 2:1** - My little children, these things I write to you, so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous.

\* Tonight we can make intercession for ourselves –

\* Whoever calls upon the name of the Lord will be saved. Rom 10:13

\* that if you confess with your mouth Jesus is Lord, and believe in your heart God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. Rom 10:9
