*Last week - 19. five to one (Pt 2)*

*This Week – 20. Unlike Father – Unlike Son*

### **2 Kings 15:32-38            Jotham King/Judah**

V32 - 2<sup>nd</sup> Year of Pekah (Israel)

V34 – Did what was right in the sight of the Lord; according to his father/Uzziah

V35 – But the people still sacrificed

V37 – In those days – Lord began to bring Rezin/Syria & Pekah/Israel against Judah

A – Why? 1) Good king/Sinful people! 2) See next Chapter – Co-reigned w/Ahaz/Bad King

### **2 Chronicles 27                            Jotham King/Judah**

\* V2 – Did what was right...according to father/Uzziah...although did not enter/Temple

A – We are not perfect, hopefully our children will learn from our errors

V3-4 – Built

V5 – Fought King/Ammonites – defeated

\* V6 – Jotham became mighty because he prepared his ways before the Lord his God!

A – 26:5 – Saw modeled in his father – but he also saw sins of his father 26:16

A – Jotham prepared his ways before the Lord – How can we?

### **Psalm 63:1-8 How did David do it?**

<sup>1</sup>A Psalm of David When He Was in the Wilderness of Judah. O God, You are my God; Early will I seek You; My soul thirsts for You; My flesh longs for You In a dry and thirsty land Where there is no water. <sup>2</sup>So I have looked for You in the sanctuary, To see Your power and Your glory. <sup>3</sup>Because Your lovingkindness is better than life, My lips shall praise You. <sup>4</sup>Thus I will bless You while I live; I will lift up my hands in Your name. <sup>5</sup>My soul shall be satisfied as with marrow and fatness, And my mouth shall praise You with joyful lips. <sup>6</sup>When I remember You on my bed, I meditate on You in the night watches. <sup>7</sup>Because You have been my help, Therefore in the shadow of Your wings I will rejoice. <sup>8</sup>My soul follows close behind You; Your right hand upholds me.

### **2 Kings 16                            Ahaz King/Judah**

V1 – 17<sup>th</sup> Year Pekah King/Israel; Reigned 16 Years

V2 – He did not do what was right in the sight of the Lord, as his “father” David had done

V3 – Description of the horrible things Ahaz did!

\* V4 – Under every green tree...A - Why some people don't have Christmas trees.

\* V5 – 2 Kings 15:37 - Why the Lord began bring Rezin & Pekah against Judah

\* V8 – Halley's Bible Handbook pg 224 – Tiglath-Pileser inscription about Ahaz!

V10-20 – Pagan worship instituted by Ahaz & assisted by Urijah the Priest!!!

## **2 Chronicles 28 Ahaz King/Judah**

\* V2-3 – Little more detail

\* V5-8 – Therefore...the Lord delivered him into the hand of the King of Syria

\* V9-15 – Israel returns captives of Judah after being rebuked by prophet Oded.
