- * End Genesis to Beginning Exodus = Aprox 400 years (Ex 12:40-41)

Exodus 2

V1-10

1. V1 – Moses = Levite
 2. V5 – What is going on? Why story pickup w/Moses?
- Gen 15:13-14 & 16** – God is making Good on His Prophecy/Promise

V11-15

- V12 – Moses' Mistakes
 - 1) Looks/This way/That way – Didn't look up!
 - 2) Hid the body in the sand!
- 1. Numbers 32:23** But if you do not do so, then take note, you have sinned against the Lord; and be sure your sin will find you out.
2. We are not able to cover our sins! Adam/Eve, Moses, US!
 3. **Proverbs 28:13** He who covers his sins will not prosper, But whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy.
- Romans 4:6-8** just as David also describes the blessedness of the man to whom God imputes righteousness apart from works: “Blessed are those whose lawless deeds are forgiven, And whose sins are covered; Blessed is the man to whom the Lord shall not impute sin.”

V16-25

1. Moses in Foreign Land – Children/Israel in Foreign Land
Isaiah 59:2 But your iniquities have separated you from your God; And your sins have hidden His face from you, So that He will not hear.
2. What do the Child/Israel do? – Cry Out!
Psalms 34:17-18 The righteous cry out, and the Lord hears, And delivers them out of all their troubles. The Lord is near to those who have a broken heart, And saves such as have a contrite spirit.
1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

V1-5

1. V2,4,6 – Angel of the Lord = God
 2. V5 – Holy Ground – What made it Holy? God's presence
- * Do not Draw Near!!!!
- Joshua 5:15** – Holy Ground! After Entering - Prior to Jericho

V6-8

1. V7 – Seen/Heard/Know their Sorrows
Isaiah 53:3-4 He is despised and rejected by men, A Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him. Surely He has borne our griefs And carried our sorrows; (Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted.)
 2. V8 – So,...I have come Down...
