

## Exodus 13-15

**LW** – Last 3 plagues & Passover/Foreshadow of Christ/Last Supper

**TW** – Begin the Exodus – Overhead Preview!

### Chapter 13

V1-10 – Feast of Unleavened Bread

\* 7 Days after the Passover – Often times combined

\* V3 – Remember! Remember/Remember!

\* Bondage – 8/times – 1:14, 2:23; 6:5, 6, 9; Here; 13:14; 20:2

\* V8-9 – Purpose/Feast Unleavened Bread! Tell next Generation/Sign

V11-16 – Redeeming Firstborn

\* V14 - Purpose – Tell how the Lord brought you up out of!!!

\* Application – Tithe/Offering – “Redeem” because Redeemed!

**1 Peter 1:18-19** knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers, but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.

V17-22 – Pillar/Cloud/Day & Pillar/Fire/Night – Only way to Go!

**Philippians 4:19** And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

### Chapter 14

V1-18

1. Contrast 13:3 with V11 & 12!!! & Ex 2:23-24 – They cried out!!!

\* God heard their cry and acknowledged them!

2. God desire – V4 & 18 – That/Egyptian’s/know that I am the LORD

\* Same with Jesus & Same today!!!

V19-31 - Miracle of Parting/Red Sea

1. If just a “Swamp” – Greater Miracle by drowning Egyptian Army!

2. Saved Israel – From Certain Death;

**Romans 6:23** For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

**Romans 1:16** For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek.

## Chapter 15

V1-19 – Song of Moses

\* V1 & Psalm 90 – Moses sang! David Sang! Manly Men Sing!

2 Samuel 22:1 (Ps 18)Then David spoke to the Lord the words of this song, on the day when the Lord had delivered him from the hand of all his enemies, and from the hand of Saul.

Psalm 65:1 To the Chief Musician. A Psalm of David. A Song. Praise is awaiting You, O God, in Zion; And to You the vow shall be performed.

Psalm 68:1 To the Chief Musician. A Psalm of David. A Song. Let God arise, Let His enemies be scattered; Let those also who hate Him flee before Him.

\* Sing about?

V1 – He has triumphed!

V2 – The Lord is my strength/song, He has become my salvation!

V3 – Lord is man of war!

V6 – Your “Right Hand” = Jesus

V11 – Who is like you, O LORD, among the ‘gods’?

V13 – Mercy, Redeemed, Guided

V18 – The Lord shall reign forever and ever...DOES HE NOW!

**Phil 4:20** Now to our God and Father be glory forever and ever. Amen.

**1 Timothy 1:17** Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, to God who alone is wise, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen.

**2 Peter 3:18** To Him be the glory both now and forever. Amen.

**Jude 25** To God our Savior, Who alone is wise, Be glory and majesty, Dominion and power, Both now and forever. Amen.

V20-21 - Worship is Contagious!

### V22-27

**V26** – If you diligently heed

**Jude 5** But I want to remind you, though you once knew this, that the Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed those who did not believe.

\* Choice to Believe!
