

## Exodus 4

### V1-9

V1 = 2<sup>nd</sup> Resistance to Calling – 1<sup>st</sup> was 3:11-13 – Understandable!

\* Moses, Saul, David, Gideon, Jeremiah, Paul –

\* “There is no man too small for God to use greatly, but there is many a man too great for God to use in small way”

**1 Samuel 9:21** And Saul answered and said, “Am I not a Benjamite, of the smallest of the tribes of Israel, and my family the least of all the families of the tribe of Benjamin? Why then do you speak like this to me?” **1 Samuel 15:17** So Samuel said, “When you were little in your own eyes, were you not head of the tribes of Israel? And did not the Lord anoint you king over Israel?”

### V10-17

\* 4 strikes/You’re are out! Lord/Angry w/Moses! Strikes of Doubt!

\* Striking out means Missing Out! God won’t use an unwilling vessel!

**Judges 4:6-9** Then she sent and called for Barak the son of Abinoam from Kedesh in Naphtali, and said to him, “Has not the Lord God of Israel commanded, ‘Go and deploy troops at Mount Tabor; take with you ten thousand men of the sons of Naphtali and of the sons of Zebulun; and against you I will deploy Sisera, the commander of Jabin’s army, with his chariots and his multitude at the River Kishon; and I will deliver him into your hand?’” And Barak said to her, “If you will go with me, then I will go; but if you will not go with me, I will not go!” So she said, “I will surely go with you; nevertheless there will be no glory for you in the journey you are taking, for the Lord will sell Sisera into the hand of a woman.” Then Deborah arose and went with Barak to Kedesh.

### V18-26

V24 – Lord sought to kill him – Why?

**Genesis 17:14** And the uncircumcised male child, who is not circumcised in the flesh of his foreskin, that person shall be cut off from his people; he has broken My covenant.” (Exodus 3:5)

**Romans 2:28-29** For he is not a Jew who is one outwardly, nor is circumcision that which is outward in the flesh; but he is a Jew who is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the Spirit, not in the letter; whose praise is not from men but from God.

**V27-31** – Believed/Worshipped! Believing = Responsive Worship!
