V3-10 = Loving the Lord!!!

**1 Timothy 4:16**<sup>16</sup> Take heed to yourself and to the doctrine. Continue in them, for in doing this you will save both yourself and those who hear you.

### Chapter 24

V1 - Joshua’s Farewell Speech to the People!

#### Point #4 – Joshua’s Challenge

V15 – If it seems evil to you to serve the Lord, choose...But as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.”

**John 3:16**<sup>16</sup> For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

**John 3:18**<sup>18</sup> “He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

John 6:60-66 – Hard saying...from that time many of his disciples went back and walked him no more

#### Point #5 – The Servant of the LORD

V29 – Joshua, the son of Nun, the servant of the LORD, died...

\* Joshua HAD served the LORD...

**Exodus 17:9-10**<sup>9</sup> And Moses said to Joshua, “Choose us some men and go out, fight with Amalek. Tomorrow I will stand on the top of the hill with the rod of God in my hand.” <sup>10</sup> So Joshua did as Moses said to him, and fought with Amalek. And Moses, Aaron, and Hur went up to the top of the hill.

**Exodus 17:13**<sup>13</sup> So Joshua defeated Amalek and his people with the edge of the sword.

**Exodus 24:13**<sup>13</sup> So Moses arose with his assistant Joshua, and Moses went up to the mountain of God.

**Exodus 33:11**<sup>11</sup> So the Lord spoke to Moses face to face, as a man speaks to his friend. And he would return to the camp, but his servant Joshua the son of Nun, a young man, did not depart from the tabernacle.

**Numbers 14:6**<sup>6</sup> But Joshua the son of Nun and Caleb the son of Jephunneh, who were among those who had spied out the land, tore their clothes;

**Numbers 27:18**<sup>18</sup> And the Lord said to Moses: “Take Joshua the son of Nun with you, a man in whom is the Spirit, and lay your hand on him;

**Joshua 1:16**<sup>16</sup> So they answered Joshua, saying, “All that you command us we will do, and wherever you send us we will go.

**Joshua 4:5**<sup>5</sup> and Joshua said to them: “Cross over before the ark of the Lord your God into the midst of the Jordan, and each one of you take up a stone on his shoulder, according to the number of the tribes of the children of Israel,
