Chapter 17 Day of Atonement = Yom Kippur

Biblical Day of Atonement/Yom Kippur

V1-2

1. Remember Lev 10:1-3 – Nadab & Abihu died
 - * Offered ‘Profane Incense’ (which He had not commanded them)
 - * 10:3 – The Reason
 - * Only God’s Offering/Sacrifices were Sufficient to cleanse/presence!
2. Don’t come just any time – Because I will appear – unclean/die!

V3-6

V3 Young Bull/Sin Offering & Ram/Burnt Offering (9:2/Yourself!)

V4 Put on the Linen...Wash - Symbolize Purity/Holiness

V5 From People - 2 Kid Goats/Sin Offering; Ram/Burnt Offering

V6 Bull = Sin Offering for Self!

V7-10

* Two Goats – 1) Lords/Sin Offering (Die) 2) Scapegoat (Live)

V10 – Scapegoat will have atonement made upon it - Live

V11 – Aaron – Kill/Bull - make atonement for Himself

V12-13

V12 – Censer burning coals – from altar – sweet incense – bring in

V13 – Incense/Coals- Cloud/Incense Cover Mercy Seat – Lest Die!

V14-15

V14 – Sprinkle some Blood/Bull/Sin/Offering/Him – Mercy Seat X 7

V15 – Do same with Blood/Goat/Sin/Offering/People – Bring/Sprinkle

V18-19 – Make Atonement/Altar/Incense – Inside Tent/Holy (40:5)

V20-22

V20 – When Made and End of Atoning for Holy Place..

V21 – Lay Hands/Live Goat – Confess Iniquities/Transgressions/Sins

V22 – Goat shall bear - Release into the Wilderness

V30 & 34 – Key!

Modern Day of Atonement/Yom Kippur

- * Keep in Mind Lev 16:29-30
- * Yom Kippur (10/9/08) is the tenth and final day of the Ten Days/Repentance which begins with Rosh Hashanah (9/30/08)
- * According to Jewish tradition, God inscribes each person's fate for the coming year into a "book" on Rosh Hashanah and waits until Yom Kippur to "seal" the verdict.
- * Day set aside to "afflict the soul," to atone for sins of the past year.
- * This day is, essentially, your last appeal, your last chance to change the judgment, to demonstrate your repentance and make amends.
- * Yom Kippur atones only for sins between man and G-d, not for sins against another person.
- * It is a complete, 25-hour fast
- * A Sabbath – 5 Services - The concluding service of Yom Kippur, known as Ne'ilah, is one unique to the day. It usually runs about 1 hour long.
- * There is a tone of desperation in the prayers of this service.
- * No Tabernacle/Temple, Bulls/Goats
- * No Offerings/Priest/People/Washing/Incense/Bloodshed/Scapegoat
- * Therefore - No Atonement & No Obedience to the Law!
- * Try to make their affliction of their soul as Sacrifice/Offering

Chapter 17

* Importance placed on blood/bloodshed by the Lord

* V11& 14 – Key!!!

Believer’s Day of Atonement/Yom Kippur

- * Heb 9:6-15 & 10:1-4 (or 10) – Jesus’ Blood/Our Atonement
- * He became our Scapegoat/Bore/Took Away our Sins!
- * Heb 10:19-25 – Our Application
- * When we pray to the Father in His name, Prayer/Incense
