Job

Chapter 20

Zophar – Round 2

V1-3

Zophar's motivation to speak

* V2-3

My anxious thoughts, turmoil w/in Me, Response to Rebuke, My Understanding

V4-29

Uses 3rd Person to accuse Job of being wicked and suffering for it

Job 20:29 This *is* the portion from God for a wicked man, The heritage appointed to him by God."

Chapter 21

Job's Response

V1-3

Job's motivation to speak

V4-21

Job lists many good things that happen to wicked

Job 21:7 Why do the wicked live *and* become old, Yes, become mighty in power?

V22-26

Only God knows why

V27-34

Look I know your thoughts – How then can you comfort me with empty words

Chapter 22

Eliphaz – Round 3

V1-11

Eliphaz directly accuses Job of specific sins!

Job 22:5 *Is* not your wickedness great, And your iniquity without end?

V12-20

Tells Job that God sees it all

V21-30

Eliphaz gives lots of "If you do this" "Then God will do this"

* V21-30

More Unbiblical Prosperity Doctrine

Chapter 23

Job's Response

V1-12

Job says he "looks for God" to talk, but can't "find him"

Job 23:10 But He knows the way that I take; *When* He has tested me, I shall come forth as gold.

Job 23:12 I have not departed from the commandment of His lips; I have treasured the words of His mouth

More than my necessary *food*.

Chapter 24

Job Continues

V1-25

God allows wickedness to exist

Job 24:25 "Now if *it is* not *so*, who will prove me a liar, And make my speech worth nothing?"

Chapter 25

Bildad – Round 3

V1-6

Asks Job in the 3rd person how he thinks he is righteous

Job 25:4 How then can man be righteous before God? Or how can he be pure *who is* born of a woman?

Chapter 26

Job's Response

V1-4

Job asks how Bildad thinks he has helped him

V5-14

Job declares God's Power & Majesty

Job 26:7 He stretches out the north over empty space; *He* hangs the earth on nothing.

Job 26:10 He drew a circular horizon on the face of the waters, At the boundary of light and darkness.

Job 26:13 By His Spirit He adorned the heavens; His hand pierced the fleeing serpent.

Job 26:14 Indeed these *are* the mere edges of His ways, And how small a whisper we hear of Him! But the thunder of His power who can understand?"

Chapter 27

Job Continues

V1-12

Job maintains his integrity and righteousness

Job 27:3-4 As long as my breath *is* in me, And the breath of God in my nostrils, My lips will not speak wickedness, Nor my tongue utter deceit.

Chapter 28

Job Speaks of Wisdom

V1-19

Wisdom - Man cannot mine for it, nor purchase it

V20-29

God is the Possessor of Wisdom

Job 28:26 When He made a law for the rain, And a path for the thunderbolt,

Job 28:28 And to man He said, ‘Behold, the fear of the Lord, that *is* wisdom, And to depart from evil *is* understanding.’ ”

Chapter 29

Job Continues

V1-11

Reflects on how his life WAS blessed

V12-17

Believed it was BECAUSE he did all these good things

V18-20

Thought it was going to be this way forever!

V21-25

Tells of his power and authority over men

Chapter 30

Job Continues

V1-15

BUT, now they all mock him, taunt him

V16-31

Describes his horrible physical & emotional condition

Job 30:30-31 My skin grows black and falls from me; My bones burn with fever. My harp is *turned* to mourning, And my flute to the voice of those who weep.

Chapter 31

Job Continues

V1-40

If I had... - Then I would deserve this

Job 31:15 Did not He who made me in the womb make them? Did not the same One fashion us in the womb?

Job 31:40 ...The words of Job are ended.

Chapter 32

Elihu Speaks

V1-5

Elihu’s motivation to speak – Wrath, Wrath, Wrath!

Job 32:1 So these three men ceased answering Job, because he *was* righteous in his own eyes.

V6-22

“I, I, I” will speak “MY opinion”

Job 32:9 Great men are not *always* wise, Nor do the aged *always* understand justice.

Chapter 33

Elihu Continues

V1-7

Elihu challenges Job to answer him

* V1-3

7 “My’s”

V8-11

Elihu says - I heard you say you were innocent

V12-28

Elihu accuses Job of being wrong and that God has sent him to turn Job around

V29-30

Elihu says God will do anything/everything 2 or 3 times to save some one

V31-33

Elihu says listen to me & I will teach you wisdom

Chapter 34

Elihu Continues

V1-9

Job has said he is righteous, but God wouldn’t do these things to the righteous

V10-33

Therefore listen to me – God wouldn’t do that, He repays man for his works

V34-37

Job lies and he is wicked

Job 34:37 For he adds rebellion to his sin; He claps *his hands* among us, And multiplies his words against God.”

Chapter 35

Elihu Continues

V1-16

Further accusations against Job

Job 35:15-16 And now, because He has not punished in His anger, Nor taken much notice of folly, Therefore Job opens his mouth in vain; He multiplies words without knowledge.”

Chapter 36

Elihu Continues

V1-4

Elihu proclaims perfect knowledge!?

V5-12

Describes God’s Might

V13-23

Accuses Job of being a Hypocrite & Wicked

V24-33

God is great and judges people in His greatness

Chapter 37

Elihu Continues

V1-13

Proclaims God’s power over creation

V14-24

Tells Job to listen & learn

Chapter 38

The Lord Speaks!

V1-3

The Lord prepares Job to hear from Him

Job 38:3 Now prepare yourself like a man; I will question you, and you shall answer Me.

Job 38:4 “Where were you when I laid the foundations of the earth? Tell *Me*, if you have understanding.

Job 38:12 “Have you commanded the morning since your days *began*, And caused the dawn to know its place,

Job 38:25 “Who has divided a channel for the overflowing *water*, Or a path for the thunderbolt,

Job 38:31 “Can you bind the cluster of the Pleiades, Or loose the belt of Orion?”

Chapter 39

The Lord Continues

V1-30

More questions proving God’s sovereignty over creation

Chapter 40

The Lord Continues

V1-7

The Lord & Job Dialogue

Job 40:2 “Shall the one who contends with the Almighty correct *Him*? He who rebukes God, let him answer it.”

Job 40:4-5 “Behold, I am vile; What shall I answer You? I lay my hand over my mouth. Once I have spoken, but I will not answer; Yes, twice, but I will proceed no further.”

Job 40:7 “Now prepare yourself like a man; I will question you, and you shall answer Me:

V8-14

The Lord asks Job if He is like God

Job 40:8-9 “Would you indeed annul My judgment? Would you condemn Me that you may be justified? Have you an arm like God? Or can you thunder with a voice like His?

Job 40:14 Then I will also confess to you That your own right hand can save you.

V15-24

The Lord uses the Behemoth as an example of His power

Job 40:15 “Look now at the behemoth, which I made *along* with you; He eats grass like an ox.

V15-24

The description certainly fits the description of a “Dinosaur.”

Chapter 41

The Lord Continues

V1-34

The Lord uses the Leviathan as an example of His power

Job 41:1 “Can you draw out Leviathan with a hook, Or *snare* his tongue with a line *which* you lower?

Job 41:10 No one *is so* fierce that he would dare stir him up. Who then is able to stand against Me?

Chapter 42

Job Humbles Himself & the Lord Restores Him

V1-6

Job humbles himself

V7-9

The Lord confronts Eliphaz, Bildad & Zophar – not spoken of Me what is right

- * V8-9 Required burnt offerings & Job to pray for them to appease God
- Job 42:10** And the LORD restored Job's losses when he prayed for his friends. Indeed the LORD gave Job twice as much as he had before.
- V11 All Job's family & friends came to eat, console & comfort him
- Job 42:12** Now the LORD blessed the latter *days* of Job more than his beginning; ...
- V13-15 Lord gives him twice what he had before, 7 sons, 3 daughters
- V16-17 Job dies at 140 years old.

Exodus

- * The birth of Israel as a nation.
- * Covers from the Birth of Moses to the Building of the Tabernacle of Meetings near Mt. Sinai
- * Contains the 10 Plagues & the 10 Commandments
- * The Israelites "Exodus" (exit/departure) was finally accomplished after the death 1st born, and going through the water of the Red Sea.

Chapter 1

Children of Israel in Egypt

- V1-6 Who and How they go to Egypt
- V7-14 Israel prospers under a King who oppresses them
- Map** Pithom & Raames (Avaris)
- V15-22 Pharaoh's plan to have all the male babies killed at birth
- Exodus 1:17** But the midwives feared God, and did not do as the king of Egypt commanded them, but saved the male children alive.

Chapter 2

Moses' Birth & Flight

- V1-10 Moses' birth & adoption by Pharaoh's daughter
- * **V1** Moses was a Levite
- * **V6** 1st Mention & Definition of Compassion
- V11-15 Moses kills an Egyptian and flees Pharaoh who tries to kill him
- V16-22 Moses marries the daughter of a Priest of Midian
- Map** Midian – Son of Abraham & Keturah, Sent East, Joseph sold to Midianites
- V23-26 God heard the groans of the people!

Chapter 3

Moses & the Burning Bush

- V1-9 God speaks to Moses from the Burning Bush
- * **V2 & 4** Angel of the Lord = God (Abraham Gen 18-19; Jacob Gen 32:28 & Hosea 12:3-4)
- Exodus 3:5** Then He said, "Do not draw near this place. Take your sandals off your feet, for the place where you stand is holy ground."
- V10-22 God's plan to send Moses, Moses Resists
- * **V11 & V14** "Who am I" instead of "Who I AM"
- Exodus 3:20** So I will stretch out My hand and strike Egypt with all My wonders which I will do in its midst; and after that he will let you go.

Chapter 4

Miraculous Signs & Moses Goes

- V1-9 God gives Moses the sign of the Rod/Snake & Leprous Hand
- * **V8** Signs confirm God's Word
- V10-17 Moses resist again saying not an eloquent speaker, God gives him Aaron
- V18-31 Lord sends Moses & Aaron back to Egypt
- Exodus 4:31** So the people believed; and when they heard that the LORD had visited the children of Israel and that He had looked on their affliction, then they bowed their heads and worshiped.
